Hello,

You may well have noticed, as did many airport residents late yesterday evening, Sunday 28 May, that there were many very late arrivals of returning easyJet Switzerland aircraft: the last two landing after midnight. Since it seems unlikely that the computer problems in London should have seriously affected the flights of easyJet Switzerland, I wonder if you could give ARAG your analysis of the reasons for the delays?

For your information, the following observations might help you shorten your time to respond :-

1. The "spare" aircraft, the A320 HB-JXA, left empty for Basel at 6am (taking off the "wrong" way : contresens!), in order to operate Basel <-> Tel Aviv, only returning to Geneva in the late afternoon!
2. After returning from Barcelona at 15h10, the A319 HB-JYF only left for Paris at 20h30.
3. Between 16h30 and 18h the runway in use was temporarily switched from 23 to 05: this forced the aircraft A320 HB-JZR to abort its landing on 23 and land on 05 instead.

Your suggestions for measures to avoid such unpleasant nights, in particular Sundays during the forthcoming Summer season, would be greatly appreciated!
